1. You must compete with one or more other WPL members. When you are ready to start your 18 hole competitive round, you first pick the cup on the practice green that you want to putt to, then look on the WPL scorecard just below the appropriate hole number and you will see the pre-determined length for that putt. Next, with the heel of your foot next to the cup you have chosen, pace off the length of the putt (all putt lengths are in paces which is a large step, approximately 3 feet) now place a coin or ball marker down at that point. Now, take your normal routine to line up the putt and when you are ready, putt for score. There are no GIMMIES. So, please putt out each hole and record the true score. Repeat this process for each of the eighteen holes, rotating which players putts first on each hole. Then, report your score to WPL in your personalized member area.
2. If a ball is putt off the green, the player may putt from where the ball has stopped or the ball may be placed back on the green, no closer to the hole, with a one stroke penalty. Note: 3 is the maximum score allowed on each hole
3. USGA Rules for equipment and anchoring apply.
